Dear SVT members and friends,

The act of protecting land depends on the passion of visionaries. Every property brought into conservation has a lengthy story of dedicated landowners, volunteers, staff, and supporters who made the project possible. Over the past year, thanks to the collaborative efforts of many, SVT permanently protected 102 more acres across four parcels and made significant progress toward conserving over 15 more properties. At the same time, we broadened our reach in the region, welcoming more people to participate in our programs, volunteer on our properties, and spend time on our trails.

We also took a firm stand to legally protect our conservation values. SVT's successful lawsuit required the restoration of streams and wetlands that had been decimated due to illegal construction in a "no-build" zone of the Baiting Brook Meadow Farm Conservation Restriction in Framingham. This precedent-setting case demonstrated SVT's commitment to the long-term care of the land we protect, and it strengthened the force of conservation restrictions across the Commonwealth.

Fiscal year 2025 was a strong year financially, thanks to generous bequests, the enduring support of SVT members, and the long-term prudent stewardship of funds by the Board of Directors. During a leadership transition, SVT staff and volunteers worked in unison to carry our new 2025-2029 Strategic Plan forward. Thanks to SVT supporters, we remain strong and well-positioned to conserve new land and care for our protected landscapes over the long term. Our local lands and waters are forever grateful.

LAND PROTECTION


SVT's impact on the land grew again in 2024-2025, as we completed four projects that permanently protected another 102 acres of habitats.



the Ashland Town Forest now spans more than 700 acres of permanently protected habitat.

SVT partnered with the Town of Ashland to protect a 53-acre property on Winter Street that boasts high-quality forests and wetlands with 9 miles of trails. Together with SVT's Cowassock Woods,

The small but mighty 6-acre **Assabet River Bluff** property in Concord, with access to the Bruce Freeman Rail Trail, is now permanently protected by a conservation restriction, jointly held by SVT and the Concord Land Conservation Trust. This unique project also had one acre of the original 7-acre parcel carved off for affordable housing.



the Town of Acton in its acquisition of the 33-acre Moritz Forest and SVT owns the conservation restriction.

Critical wetlands on the Nashoba Brook Corridor in Acton are now permanently protected. SVT, the Acton Conservation Trust, and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts supported

In concert with the Town of Stow, SVT acquired the 10-acre **Harvard Road Conservation Area** that buffers a wetland complex near the 580-acre Delaney Wildlife Management Area.



OUTREACH

More than 1,900 people attended the 135 programs, outings, and events that SVT hosted in 2024-2025.

Outdoor Voices

SVT's new Outdoor Voices Speakers' Series brings varied perspectives to our program offerings so all voices are heard.



Amarachukwu Ifeji, a grassroots environmental justice advocate, described how she **combats the injustices of environmental exclusion.**

Sagamore Strong Bear Medicine of the Nashobah Praying Indians and historian Daniel V. Boudillion discussed **the Nashobah people, their journey of suffering and survival**, and their sacred lands in the region.



Public Programs: Free for All

To make it easier for everyone to enjoy nature, SVT has removed one barrier to access: A **membership with SVT is no longer required to attend our free guided nature hikes, animal shows, or Outdoor Voices Speaker Series.** When we must charge a fee for programs with significant underlying costs, everyone will pay the same amount, regardless of membership.



Accessible All Persons' Trail



In May 2025, SVT broke ground on **our first-ever accessible trail**, which is now open to the public. Located at Wolbach Farm in Sudbury, the trail also features an accessible Picnic Grove and a Barn-view Terrace where everyone can relax and enjoy spending time outdoors.

In 2026 and 2027, we will extend the trail into the woods, improve our Storybook Path, and add a nature playground and interpretive features.

STEWARDSHIP

As of June 2025, SVT cares for more than 6,000 acres of habitats in 95 SVT-owned conservation areas and 103 conservation restrictions (CRs).

Restoring a Globally Rare Habitat

Our efforts to restore the pitch pine-scrub oak barrens habitat at **Memorial Forest and the Desert Natural Area** reached a new milestone when SVT and the City of Marlborough conducted a prescribed fire on 40 acres in March 2025. By June, pitch pines and scrub oaks were regrowing and providing essential habitat for many native birds, insects, turtles, and plants that are in decline. Wild lupines benefit from periodic fire, which helps them germinate. After this burn, we may see especially vibrant displays in the coming years.



Clearing Space for Native Plants

Through hand pulling, herbicide treatments, and mechanical controls, SVT has reduced the amount of invasive Asian bittersweet at our beautiful **Smith Conservation Land** in Littleton.

In 2025, many native plants naturally reappeared or increased in abundance, and we also planted two dozen native trees that were provided for free by the DCR's Forest Program.



Improving Urban Open Space

Nestled in an urban residential area, SVT's **Centennial Park** provides neighborhood access to the Sudbury River, just upstream from the Saxonville Dam. With assistance from Friends of Saxonville, Keep Framingham Beautiful, and Framingham High School's Environmental Club, we cleared trash and removed invasive plants to improve the habitat and create a pleasant nature recreation spot.

Creating & Maintaining Trails

In 2024-2025, SVT worked with the Upton Conservation Commission to create a 2-mile trail, 4 bridges and boardwalks, and a parking area at the new **District 9 Schoolhouse Conservation Area** on Mechanic Street. We also collaborated with partners in the Town of Berlin to complete a 1.5-mile trail at **Highland Ridge Woods** on Highland Street.

Plus, as part of our maintenance of existing trails, SVT and our conservation partners built or repaired bridges at **Elliott Concord River Preserve** in Carlisle and **Memorial Forest** in Sudbury.



VOLUNTEERS

SVT's 200+ volunteers contributed more than 2,300 hours in Fiscal 2025. They worked on our properties, represented SVT at events, took photos of nature, helped in our office, served on committees, and more.



High School Students

SVT enjoys engaging high school students in our work. In 2024–2025, students from Acton-Boxborough Regional High School, Lincoln-Sudbury Regional High School, and Middlesex High School **removed invasive plants** and assisted with general property cleanup.



Weed Warriors

The Weed Warrior volunteers who remove invasive plants from conservation lands are **improving native habitats** at Wolbach Farm, Smith Conservation Land, Gowing's Swamp, and Memorial Forest.

In 2024–2025, we planned 54 Weed Warrior events, with 36 individuals contributing over 300 hours to the effort.

Preserve Stewards

Volunteer Preserve Stewards are SVT's eyes and ears on our lands. In 2024–2025, our 59 Preserve Stewards walked our trails to **clean up trash, cut back brush**, and note issues that need staff attention.

Financial Summary


SVT ended Fiscal 2025 with a surplus, due primarily to positive investment returns and two extraordinary bequests that will have a lasting impact on SVT's work. These one-time, purpose restricted bequests strengthen the long-term outlook for the organization and provide ready funds for direct land acquisition.

Meanwhile, annual unrestricted gifts from individual donors (and sweat equity from passionate volunteers) provide the yearly support that is critical to sustain the rapid pace of our work as operational costs increase year over year. In other words, we could not do it without you!




